POLYNESIAN OPTIMIST 2024 CHAMPIONSHIP NOTICE OF RACE

The Polynesian Optimist 2024 Championship will take place in Tahiti, North coast, from Monday May 20nd to Thursday May 23th 2024.

The organization is entrusted to the Yacht Club of Tahiti under the authority of the Tahitian Sailing Federation (FTV).

The races are governed by the Racing Rules for Sailing Boats 2021/2024, the FTV regulations, the Optimist Class rules and the present Sailing Instructions and their appendices. The event is open to competitors aged between 6 and 15 years old in the current year.

Programme :

Monday 20nd: Opening ceremony at 5 pm in the Yacht Club Hall

Tuesday 21 : 1 to 5 race championship. First signal ashore at 09h30 A, B and C Wednesday 22: 1 to 5 race championship. First signal ashore 09:30 A, B and C Thursday 23: Championship 1 to 5 races. First signal ashore 09h30 A, B and C Thursday 23th from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm: prize giving ceremony + meal at the end of the regatta A, B and C

Individual championship :

If the number of registrations exceeds the possibility of loaning boats, we will sail in pools.

20 races are planned, 3 races must be run to validate the championship.

The ranking system used is the Minima Points system.

Registration:

The participation is 10 000xpf / competitor member of a club affiliated to the FTV or FFV.

The registration includes: Lunch basket for regattas and meal at the end of the championship for the competitors.

For the meal at the end of the championship, the accompanying persons can participate by reserving directly at the Y.C.T. restaurant.

Registrations for the regatta must be received in writing at the secretariat of the Yacht Club de Tahiti no later than SATURDAY, MAY 11, 2024. <u>contact@yctahiti.org</u>

After this date and until Tuesday, May 21, 8:00 a.m., it will be possible to register with an additional fee of 2000Xpf/pers.

The event is open to Optimist A, B and C series.

A valid license is required. The race instructions are posted on the official YCT notice board.

Individual championship :

If the number of registrations exceeds the possibility of loaning boats, we will sail in pools.

20 races are planned, 3 races must be run to validate the championship.

The ranking system used is the Minima Points system.

Boats provided by the organization :

The boats are provided by the organization.

Any damage or loss is the responsibility of the winner, who will be responsible for all damages.

Advertising category :

The competitors must reserve the front quarter of the hull on each side for the organization's advertising.

Jury :

The jury is composed of 3 members. The jury will be present on the water and will enforce the rules directly.

Prizes:

A trophy will be awarded to the first three of each category:

- Champion of Polynesia Open series A
- Champion of Polynesia A series
- Polynesian Open Champion Series B
- Polynesian Champion C series

Sail identification:

The sails must be in accordance with Appendix H of the RCV.
