NOTICE OF RACE

The Oceania Optimist and ILCA4 2025 Championship will be held in Tahiti, North Coast, from Tuesday April 01 to Friday, April 04, 2025.

Organization is entrusted to the Tahiti Yacht Club under the authority of the Tahitian Sailing Federation (FTV).

The races are governed the 2021/2024 racing rules for sailboats, as prescribed by the FTV, Optimist and ILCA4 class rules and the present sailing instructions and their appendices. The event is open to competitors aged between 6 and 15 in the current year.

Program

Tuesday 01: Championship 1 to 5 races. First signal ashore at 09:30 + Opening ceremony at 16:00 in the Club Hall.

Wednesday 02: Championship 1 to 5 races. First signal ashore 09:30

Thursday 03: Championship 1 to 5 races. First signal ashore 09:30

Friday 04: Championship 1 to 5 races. First signal ashore 09:30

Friday 04 from 18:00 to 22:00: prize-giving ceremony + end-of-regatta meal

Individual championship.

If the number of entrants exceeds the number of boats available for loan, we will sail in pools.

20 races are scheduled, and 3 races must be run to validate the championship.

The ranking system used is the Minima Points system.

Entries:

The entry fee is 10 000xpf / competitor member of a club affiliated to the FTV or FFV.

Registration includes: breakfast, lunch, snack and the end-of-championship meal for competitors.

For the end-of-championship meal, accompanying persons can participate by reserving directly at the Y.C.T. restaurant.

Entries for the regatta must be received in writing by the secretariat of the Yacht Club de Tahiti no later than SATURDAY, March 22, 2025. yctahiti@gmail.com

After this date and until Tuesday, April 01 at 8:00 am, it will be possible to register with a surcharge of 5000Xpf/pers.

The event is open to Optimist A and C series.

A valid license is required. Race instructions are posted on the official YCT notice board.

Boats provided by the organization :

Any damage or loss is the responsibility of the successful bidder, who will be liable for all damages.

Advertising category.

Competitors must reserve the front quarter of the hull on each side for the organization's advertising.

Jury: The jury is composed of 3 members. The jury will be present on the water and will directly enforce the rules.

Sail identification: Sails must comply with Appendix H of the RRS.
